### 2018 TENGA Global Self-Pleasure Study Overview

In partnership with TENGA and Burson-Marsteller, PSB set out create a global portrait of behaviors and attitudes regarding human health, wellness, sexuality, and masculinity. To this end, the PSB team launched a study in 18 different countries spread across the major regions of the world.

The goal of this study was to help TENGA lead global discourse around important topics related to sex, masturbation, and sex toy usage.

### 2018 TENGA Global Self-Pleasure Study Methodology

To ensure a representative sample of the 18-74 population in each market surveyed, PSB implemented fielding quotas and weighted final data to match the best available population statistics from each country on the basis of age and gender:







### How Men See Themselves vs. How People See Men in Germany


How German men view themselves often differs significantly from national perception of men—men see themselves as believing in workplace and domestic equality, and comfortable discussing mental health.


### How Men See Themselves vs. How People See Men in Germany (cont.)

German men are far less likely to see physical strength as an important part of their lives, and also far less likely to be comfortable being aggressive than what is assumed.




### How People See Their Current Male Partner vs. Their Ideal Male Partner

### How People See Their Current Male Partner vs. Their Ideal Male Partner (cont.)


Similarly, people interested in men see their ideal partner as someone who is open to using sex toys and is comfortable talking about masturbation compared with how people describe their current male partner.


### How Men See Themselves vs. How People See Their Current Male Partner

## Pressure to Act "Like Men" by Generation

German Men 18-34 and 35-54 are similarly likely to report they've been pressured to act a certain way as men. Older men are less likely to say so.






# Global Comparison: Men Talking About Masturbation

Compared globally, German men rank in the middle in comfort about talking to a male friend about masturbation. The majority (64%) are not comfortable.




## Men who "Feel More"

A man who "feels more" is more open with his feelings and desires, and more empathetic and inclusive of others.

For the purposes of this study, we defined a man who "feels more" as a man who **agrees that they are:** 

- A man who is in touch with his own emotions and the emotions of the people around him
- A man who is comfortable talking about his feelings or personal challenges
- A man who is comfortable interacting with people of all sexual orientations
- A man who is open to trying new sexual experiences
- A man who believes women and men should have equal roles in workplace






### Men Who "Feel More" are More Satisfied

Men in Germany who "feel more" evaluate their sex life as more satisfying across all metrics, especially on quality of masturbation (87% vs. 66%) and frequency of masturbation (85% vs. 62%).





84% of men who "feel more" in Germany masturbate at least a few times a month (vs. 67% of other men). 63% of men who "feel more" have talked to their partner about masturbation.



**Q:** Have you ever talked to your significant other about masturbation? *Among those with partners* 




### Men Who "Feel More" Have More Self-Esteem

Q: Do you think you have a beautiful body?


#### Q: How much self-confidence do you have? (On a scale from 1 to 5)




### Men Who "Feel More" are More Open to Sex Toys

Q: How comfortable would you be giving a sex toy as a gift to <u>a close male friend</u>:












### Comfort with Receiving and Giving Sex Toys







### Global Comparison: How Open are Men to Buying a Sex Toy?

**Q: Are you open to the idea of buying a sex toy for yourself in the future?** % who said Yes





Compared globally, Germans rank in the middle in believing sex toys are useful for men and women equally.


Q: When you think of sex toys, do you think they are more useful for pleasuring males, females, or both sexes equally?





### Global Comparison: The Good Sex Index

The **Good Sex Index** scores each country based on the self-reported satisfaction with sex life across all of the metrics on the previous page. Satisfaction on each individual metric is weighted by how important respondents in a country ranked it among other metrics.






### Masturbation in Germany by Gender

### Similar percentages of Germans of all age groups have tried masturbating, but frequency decreases with age.






### Masturbation Routines

Among those who have a regular masturbation routine



## Why Don't Germans Masturbate?




#### Masturbate at Least Weekly vs. Less Frequent than Weekly


Q: How much self-confidence do you have? (On a scale from 1 to 5)







93% of German men have tried masturbating—slightly lower than other countries surveyed. German women are comparatively higher at 76%

#### **Q: Have you ever tried masturbating?** % who said Yes








#### Global Comparison: Who Has Tried Masturbating?




#### Global Comparison: Who Has Tried Masturbating?












#### **Q: Did you receive sex education in school as a child or teenager?** *Showing % who said Yes*


Germans are slightly more likely to have masturbation covered in sex education when compared globally, yet the number, one in five, is still low.

A majority (69%) of Germans believe masturbation should be part of sexual education, but this number is less than other countries.




